Please let this letter serve as a notification for all childcare operations within the City of Indianapolis. The City of Indianapolis does not require a general business license to operate within the City/County limits. For certain businesses outlined in Title IV of the Revised Code of the Consolidated City and County, the Department of Business and Neighborhood Services does provide licensure services.

At this time, child care facilities and in-home daycare operations do not require a license from the City of Indianapolis/Marion County.

All childcare operations will need to follow all zoning code standards outlined in Chapter 740 of the Revised Code. If they plan any changes to their structures to accommodate the daycare operation, they will need to apply for the appropriate building permits through our office.
